

## **Casper Golf Report Nearly Ready for Board Review**

The Golf Advisory Committee continues to finalize the Billy Casper Golf report, in preparation for presentation to the RVRMA Board. Once the Board has had a chance to fully review the report, it will be shared, in its entirety, with the RVR community.

As mentioned before in this space, the report will **not** make recommendations regarding potential Board and community actions; instead, the report will provide data the Board could use to determine its own recommendation to RVR homeowners. Ultimately, any actions taken regarding the golf course will come from a vote of the RVR community.

## **Open Space Exploration Beginning to Take Shape**

The Board and Golf Advisory Committee are currently reviewing a new proposal from our open space consultant, DHM Design. DHM's Carbondale office is expected to help us get a handle on costs and options of potentially converting the golf course to something other than a golf course. The first task is to define what we mean by "open space."

The open space exploration is in its early stages. We hope to have a final report on open space possibilities available over the next few months. That report, when complete, will also be shared with RVR homeowners.

## **The Board's Top Priorities in its Golf Course Evaluation**

Finally, a reminder: as the Board considers possible actions down the road regarding the golf course or open space, its focus will be on three key objectives:

- Ensuring long-term sustainability and well-being of the community
- Preventing development that changes the nature of the community
- And, preserving RVR property values
