Board, Golf Committee Working to Finalize Casper Golf Report

Representatives of the RVRMA Board and Golf Advisory Committee have been working closely with Billy Casper Golf, our consultant, to finalize the Casper Golf report.

Casper Golf delivered a draft of the report to the Board and Golf Committee a few weeks ago. Since then, the Board and Committee have been in continual communication with the Casper Golf team, making sure the report meets all of the RVR community's needs as it assesses how best to address the golf course situation.

The report focuses on the economics of operating the course, identifies long-term capital needs, provides a "fair market value" for the golf course, and estimates what effect a golf course closure could have on RVR property values.

The Board and Committee expect to have the report finalized in early- to mid-December.

After the Board has a chance to review and digest the final report, it will share the report with RVR homeowners.
